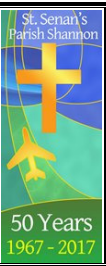

Fr. J as he was affectionately known, died peacefully in Milford Care Centre on Monday morning last. Aged 93 years, Fr. J was born in the Parish of Bodyke and was ordained a Priest 67 years ago next Sunday.



In 1983, he was appointed to Shannon where he served for 5 years, moving to

Castleconnell 30 years ago when Canon Brendan replaced him. His funeral took place in Castleconnell on Thursday. The chalice that is used in SS John & Paul Church was donated to the Parish in recent years by Fr. J. It was the chalice Fr. J used all his life in celebrating the Eucharist. We are grateful that it was Shannon Parish that he entrusted this sacred vessel that we continue to use in his name.
