CPR Tips!

Every year in Ireland, almost 5000 people die from sudden cardiac arrest. A campaign is underway to promote public awareness of what to do, should they witness the sudden collapse of an adult.



When an adult has a sudden cardiac arrest, his or her survival depends greatly on immediately getting CPR from someone nearby. From the moment of collapse, the chance of survival decreases by 7-10% per minute when CPR is not being performed. Hesitation costs lives.

Remember to "Check, Call, Compress". This will help save lives and improve the outcome of those who suffer a cardiac arrest.

CHECK – is the person unresponsive and not breathing?

CALL – Call 999 or 112

COMPRESS – Push hard and fast in the centre of the chest until help arrives.
