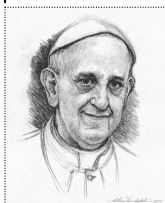
Congratulations to Sean Kerr, Cill Chais and Catherine Neville, Sixmilebridge, who were married in Sixmilebridge Church on Saturday.
