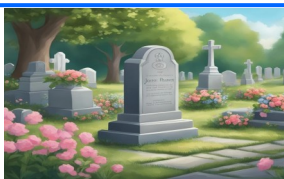

For the last few weeks, they have been diligently preparing for this under the direction of Music Director Tony Chapman and conductor Dereck Withero. Past members of the Brass Band will be remembered at the 6pm Mass on Saturday June 27th in Our Lady of the Rosary Church Newmarket-on-Fergus. The Brass Band will play at this Mass and immediately afterwards they will play the four pieces they will be playing in the competition in Clonakilty. This is a great opportunity for the people of Newmarket-on-Fergus to show their support for the band and wish them well representing Clare in this national competition.
