- P. Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting? C. I do
- P. And may almighty God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given us new birth by water and the Holy Spirit and bestowed on us forgiveness of our sins. keep us by his grace, in Christ Jesus our Lord, for eternal life. C: Amen.

The Priest sprinkles the people with the blessed water, while all sing:
