Mary, Queen assumed into Heaven, pray for us, that we may one day share in the joy and glory you now enjoy. Amen

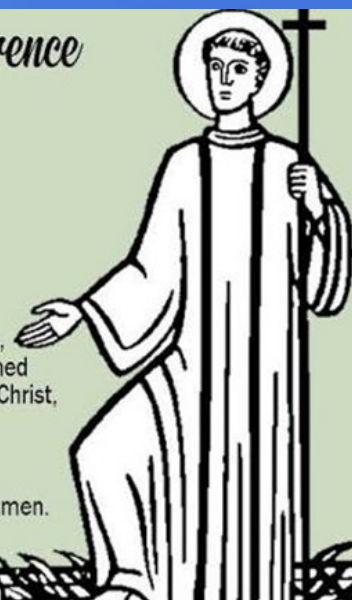
